Judy Gordon is a MACS member and a tutor for the mosaic group held each Wednesday morning from 10 am at the MACS Studio, 24 Glasshouse Rocks Road, Narooma. Visitors welcome for the first two visits to check it out.

Judy lives in Dalmeny with her husband Ron and her wonderful AWL rescue dog, Daisy. Having retired from full-time Agriculture and Science teaching in Tumut 12 years ago, Judy immediately started mosaic classes. She was hooked pretty quickly and has been mosaicking ever since. Judy joined MACS after retiring to Dalmeny and soon started weekend workshops which quickly established a group, getting together to mosaic at the old MACS cottage. Many members have come and gone but a solid group still enjoys both the social aspects and the challenges of what to make next at the new MACS Studios.

Pottery is also on during Wednesday mornings and Judy has been occasionally making clay tiles and objects to include in her work. After exhibiting mosaics in the annual MACS Open Easter Exhibition over the years, Judy has been successful in winning awards and in selling her work. She once "sold" the same chair three times!

Judy is also a member of the Artful 9, another group of mainly mosaicists who have held exhibitions at the SoArt Gallery venue. When she can tear herself away from the mosaics, Judy also enjoys painting and admits she is mad about dogs, as are her friends, many of whom also have rescue dogs like Daisy.
