Conditions of Entry - Boats Afloat Exhibition

at Narooma Sport and Game Fishing Club - from 11 to 13 November 2022

1. An entrant must be a financial member of Montague Art & Craft Society (MACS).
2. Entry Forms and fees must be received by Friday 4 November 2022.
3. All artwork to be themed - [MARITIME & MARINE](#) and/or [TREASURES OF THE SEA](#)
4. MACS will charge 20% commission on works sold.
5. All work must be the original work of the entrant.
6. 2D work must not exceed 1 metre by 1 metre.
7. 3D work must not exceed 50cm by 50cm by 50cm and must not weigh more than 10 kg.
8. 2D entries must be ready for hanging with D rings and wire.
9. 3D work must be stable and safe for display.
10. All work must be clearly labelled with the information on the Labels provided.
11. Artwork that is in any way considered to be offensive or generally inappropriate will not be displayed. The Committee reserves the right to make that decision and no correspondence will be entered into.
12. Artworks are to be delivered to Narooma Sport and Game Fishing Club On Friday 11 November between 10am and 12noon and picked up from the Club on Monday 14 November between 10am and 12noon.
13. All care will be taken but the committee, the volunteers working on the exhibition, and organisers cannot be held responsible for any damage to the artwork during the exhibition, including set-up and take-down.
14. The committee reserves the right to allow reproduction of exhibitors' work for publicity or promotional purposes.
15. The entrant accepts sole responsibility for ensuring the work does not infringe copyright laws.
16. There is a restriction on the display area. While every effort will be made to display all artwork entered, it may be necessary to restrict the number displayed. It will be up to the committee's discretion which entries are not displayed.
