"Blue painting is of Narooma and titled "Mill Bay Inlet Ghost Fishermen" as it is revealing night reflections, with outlines of friends long passed, eternally fishing.

In honour of my old fisher-mate Ron Gordon, whose last fishing expedition was from the boardwalk at Mill Bay.

He was the only successful angler that day.

Materials: Polymer Acrylic on linen."

"Second painting is;

"Memory of the shoreline after landing in the Kimberley".

Painted by memory after landing by boat from HMAS ASSAIL circa 1973.



Part of the patrol boat routine was to inspect various shore landing points and to go inland looking for visitors to the remote coast.

It was during the time of lots of refugees from Vietnam, and to search for camps often set up by illegal fishermen. The local Aboriginals became invaluable providing information on visitors to their tribal areas.




