Conditions of Entry – Boats Afloat Exhibition 2025

Yellow Boat Shed, 7 Riverside Drive, Narooma – 31 October – 2 November

Theme - Maritime

- 1. An entrant must be a financial member of Montague Art & Craft Society (MACS).
- 2. Entries close Friday, 24 October 2025.
- 3. MACS will charge 20% commission on works sold.
- 4. All work must be the original work of the entrant.
- 5. 2D work must not exceed 1m by 1m.
- 6. 3D work must not exceed 50cm by 50cm by 50cm and must not weigh more than 10 kg.
- 7. 2D entries must be ready for hanging with D rings and wire.
- 8. 3D work must be stable and safe for display.
- 9. All work to be clearly labelled on the back with the Artist name, contact details, title and price.
- 10. Artwork that is in any way considered to be offensive or generally inappropriate will not be displayed. The Committee reserves the right to make that decision and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 11. Artwork to be delivered to the boat shed on Thursday, 30 October between 10am and midday.

 Pick up unsold work on Sunday 2 November between 4 pm and 5pm.
- 12. All care will be taken but the committee, the volunteers working on the exhibition, and organisers cannot be held responsible for any damage to the artwork during the exhibition, including set-up and takedown.
- 13. The committee reserves the right to allow reproduction of exhibitors' work for publicity or promotional purposes.
- 14. The entrant accepts sole responsibility for ensuring the work does not infringe copyright laws.
- 15. There is a restriction on the display area. While every effort will be made to display all artwork entered, it may be necessary to restrict the number displayed. It will be up to the committee's discretion which entries are not displayed.
- 16. The Boat Shed access may be difficult for some people if so, please ask for help.
